



Call for papers

The Review

The Law, Market and Technology Review's mission is to promote the debate among academics and stakeholders in relation to the social and business scenario currently stimulated by the interaction between new technologies, business and law, from both a interdisciplinary and comparative perspective. The Review deals with issues related to intellectual property law, antitrust and competition law, commercial practices and consumer protection law, biotechnology law, electronic communication law, new technologies and personal data protection, fundamental rights and liability online. The Review is published on quarterly basis and it is available online and on paper.

Call for papers

With this Call for papers, the Law, Market and Technology Review aims at elaborating and discussing, through the submission of papers, the issues related to the following subjects: culture, industry and intellectual property; market, competition and regulation; commercial practices and consumer protection; biotechnology, ogm and life; electronic communications and audio-visual; fundamental rights and liability online; copyright online. Nevertheless, the Review will take into consideration submitted papers dealing with law and economics in general, even if not specifically related to the subject above mentioned.

The most interesting papers will be published in one of the following numbers of the Review.

Furthermore, the most relevant papers according to the Scientific Committee's evaluation will be taken into consideration for future workshops. The details for the participation in the workshops will be discussed later on by the Committee and the authors whose papers will have been selected.

The Review also welcomes the submission of a short curriculum vitae by authors.

Editing instructions

- Papers shall be edited according to the Journal Editing Rules (Regole Redazionali della Rivista);
- Papers shall not be shorter than 11 folders and not longer than 55; papers shall be submitted along with the abstract;
- Papers submitted shall not be already published nor accepted for publishing by any other

online or paper journal, book or paper collection;

- The Review will accept papers in Italian, English or French. Papers in other languages will be subject to discretionary evaluation by the Review.

Submission of abstracts

The Review welcomes the submission of an abstract no longer than 800 words with deadline on the 31st of March 2016.

The Executive Committee will preliminarily evaluate the abstract submitted.

Selected papers

The authors whose papers have been selected will be required to submit the full paper by the 30st of April 2016. The Review will inform authors whether their papers have been successfully selected for publication.
